- Write a one paragraph summary of what happens in your verses, which you will read at your ceremony, in place of reading a word for word translation. We don't want commentary, just a summary.

FAQ

- A Parsha is what we call the section of Torah that is read in a particular week.
- A verse is a sentence.
- You may have to read your entire parsha to find the verses that interest you.
- You do not have to select the first six verses.
- An aliyah (plural aliyot) is a section of at minimum 3 verses of Torah that is preceded and followed by a blessing.
