Students may miss and make-up 2 classes

Read afterword of God in the Wilderness and write about it as your journal entry and put it in your journal replacing the missed class question and answer.

What did it motivate you to do, to not do, or to think about?

What questions did it answer for you?

What questions did it create?

What surprised you?

What resonated with you?

What did you agree with?

What did you disagree with?

Make-up Assignment # 2:

Read Intro, chapter 1 and chapter 2 of The God Upgrade and write about it as journal entry.
